

A. Status Review- provided by Cindy Rhodes

1. Society Act

The IRA is a not-for-profit organization and complies with the Societies Act (SBC 2015) and the IRA Bylaws.

The purposes of the IRA as set out in the IRA Constitution are:

1. To promote road running and cross country running in the Okanagan Valley, Kamloops, Salmon Arm, Revelstoke, and other communities in British Columbia.
2. To assist and support other existing associations, organizations and programs that are not at variance with the objectives and aims of the Society.
3. To promote and arrange racing competitions and to offer, grant and contribute towards prizes and awards and distinctions.
4. To purchase and administer the necessary equipment to support the purposes of the Society.
5. To fundraise to support the purpose of the Society.
6. To ensure that the Society's finances and properties are not misused or used for purposes at variance with the purposes of the Society.

2. BC Athletics Series Requirements

IRA Series races must be sanctioned by BC Athletics

Purpose of sanctioning:

1. Ensures a commitment by the event organizer that the event will be conducted in accordance with the IAAF, Athletics Canada and BC Athletics rules.
2. Ensures that the event will be conducted in a fair and safe manner.
3. Ensures the recognition of results (provided there is compliance with #1 above).
4. Ensures that the event meets a standard of quality required for sanctioning by BC Athletics.

3. Current Sponsorship
